The St. Louis All-Suburban Middle School Band is an honor band consisting of students in grades 7 and 8 from throughout the St. Louis area. Students selected to this group have the distinction of representing their schools at the All-Suburban Honors Band Concert held in January 2017. All-Suburban Band members also have the opportunity to work with and learn from an outstanding guest conductor as well as with other talented student musicians from the St. Louis area. Please note that both the All-Suburban Middle School Honor Band and the Honor Jazz Band auditions will be held on the same evening at the same time and location.

In order to participate, students accepted to the ensemble must attend all rehearsals and the performance.

APPLICATION/REGISTRATION

- Registration for auditions will be done by directors and/or their students by going to the SLSMEA website. Click on the appropriate honor group page (band, orchestra, or choir) and click on the "On-Line Registration Link" for the group you wish to register for. Students auditioning for more than one instrument only need to register ONCE. Just make sure you answer all the questions on the page. If a student is auditioning for BOTH concert and jazz band, you only need to register that student ONCE. Just make sure you answer ALL the questions on the registration page. Once you have completed the registration page for that student, click SUBMIT. You WILL NOT receive a confirmation. Once registration closes for each group, directors will have a chance to verify their school's entries through the verification process. Audition times and room assignments will be EMAILED to directors the

week of October 17. **Directors are strongly encouraged to handle the entire registration process for all of their students.**

- **REGISTRATION WILL BEGIN Monday, September 26 at 6:00 a.m. REGISTRATION will conclude Friday, October 7 at MIDNIGHT.**
- On October 24, directors/school representative will need to check-in and certify that the registered students are members of their junior high/middle school band program and meet all requirements of SLSMEA.
- Auditions are blind; the judges will not see the students auditioning.
- The audition fee is \$10.00 per audition and you must pay for all auditions that have registered. If you register 10 students who will be taking 15 different auditions, you owe \$150.00 even if only 9 actual auditions take place on October 24. This is consistent with the state audition process. Once students are registered, directors will receive an invoice from SLSMEA with payment instructions. Upon receiving that invoice, directors will have 30 days to submit their payment for the audition fees.
- When students arrive at Clayton High School, they will go to the registration desk in the cafeteria to pick up their registration form that will be waiting for them. Students must have this form to audition.
- Students will not be permitted to audition without an application on file.

AUDITION INSTRUCTIONS

- Students will not be given an audition number. The audition judge will only recognize you by your audition time and instrument. You will be met at your audition room by a room monitor who will double check with you as to your audition time and confirm your name. This information will not be made available to the judge.
- Audition times and room assignments will be EMAILED to band directors by the end of the week of October 17.
- Report to your audition room 10 minutes prior to your audition. The room Monitor will call you by your audition time when it is your time to audition.
- Avoid talking to the judge. If you have any questions, ask the room monitor.
- Failure to report to your audition at your assigned time may result in you not being able to audition.

AUDITION PROCEDURES

- Plan to arrive at Clayton High School 30 minutes before your assigned audition time.
- **PLEASE DO NOT ARRIVE AT Clayton High SCHOOL BEFORE 4:30pm unless you have a 4:30 audition time. 4:30 auditionees may show up at 4:10pm.**
- **Students/directors must register on-line by Friday, October 9 at midnight.**

- **Scales (for Concert Band auditions) are listed in CONCERT PITCH** and **do not** need to be memorized. Concert C, F, Bb, Eb, Ab, and Chromatic – 2 octaves if possible (no scales required for percussion).
- **Percussion auditions...**All students must bring their own snare drum. Timpani will be provided and they will already be tuned. A set of bells, a xylophone, and a marimba will be available to accommodate the instrument that the students most practice on their own. Vibes will not be available because they will be used for Jazz auditions at the same time.
- Concert Band audition etudes are from the rotating audition sets adopted in 1998. This year we will use **SET #1**.
- **Sight-reading (4-8 measures) for all wind instruments. Percussion sight-reads on snare drum.**
- There will be a directors' hospitality room where you will find food and soda in the main office.
- Students will pick up registration form in the cafeteria. The form will also be emailed to Band Directors prior to the event.
- Remember, students that do not register on-line by October 7 will **NOT** be allowed to audition.
- **REMINDER** –In order to keep auditions flowing smoothly and quickly, students may only be asked to play sections of the etudes. Students should, however, prepare all etudes in their entirety. Sight reading examples will be at about the same difficulty level as the prepared etudes.

AUDITION RESULTS

Audition results will be emailed to directors within 24-48 hours after auditions conclude. If students are auditioning for multiple ensembles and are selected for both the concert and jazz bands, they will be asked to choose one. This also applies to students auditioning across band, choir, and orchestra. Students may only be in one Honors ensemble. Ask your students to be available at home after auditions so that they may choose which group they most prefer.

ATTENTION DIRECTORS

While the SLSMEA Middle School Band is not covered under the MSHSAA rules requiring directors to be present at rehearsals, you are welcome and encouraged to attend and assist with rehearsal supervision. Directors will be needed to run sectional rehearsals on some rehearsal nights, most likely November 21, 2016. Please consider volunteering to help with these rehearsals so that we can have smaller, more productive sectional groups.
